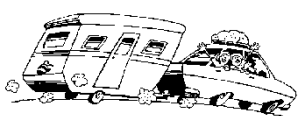

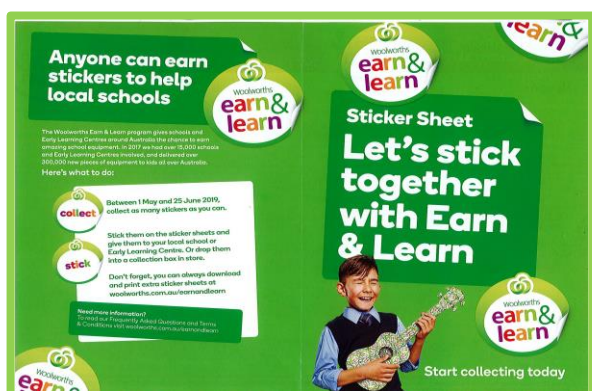
## Parents and Friend Free Breakfast

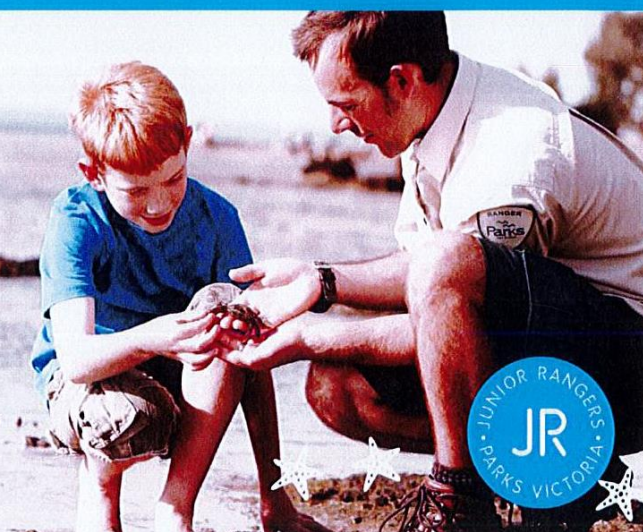
