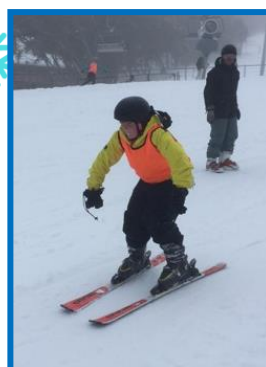
2018 PREP ENROLMENTS – FINAL CALL
