

Zucchini Slice by Sam Skoblar Ingredients

5 eggs

1 cup self raising flour

2 large zucchini - grated

1 onion - finely chopped 250g bacon - chopped

1 cup grated cheese

 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup - Vegetable Oil

Method

Pre-Heat oven to 170C, grease and line 30x20cm lamington pan.

Beat eggs in large bowl, add flour & whisk until smooth, add zucchini, onion, bacon, cheese, oil and stir to combine. Pour into pan and cook for 40 mins or until cooked through.


