TASTY CORN FRITTERS!!

Ingredients (You will need)

Method (Steps)


- * 1 cup self-raising flour
- * 2 eggs
- * 1/3 cup milk
- * 2 x 420g cans corn kernels, drained.
- * 2 tablespoons chopped chives
- * 100g fetta, crumbled - optional
- * 30g piece cold butter
- * 1 small ayo', cut into wedges
- * 30g baby rocket

1. Place flour into a large mixing bowl and make a well in the centre. Use a fork to whisk eggs and milk in a jug and pour into the flour, stirring gently to combine. Fold in corn, chives and fetta. Don't over-mix or the fritters will be tough.

2. Wrap butter in a piece of paper towel. Heat a large frying pan over medium heat and wipe with the butter to grease. Drop 1/4 cupfuls of the mixture into the pan (you'll need to cook in batches). Cook for about 2-3 mins, until golden brown underneath, then turn and cook the other side.

3. Ta da! You've created a delicious batch of fritters! These taste even better with some sweetchilli sauce, now enjoy!


