Wet weather may have slowed the start of this year's Energy Breakthrough, but nothing was stopping the Toogoolook Primary School team, who travelled from the Mornington Peninsula, as they presented their bike to the judges on Thursday morning.

Trucks, carnival rides and construction equipment has been rolling into town over the past week as excitement builds for one of Maryborough's biggest annual events,

the Energy Breakthrough.

Princes Park was bustling with activity yesterday as the 2018 event got underway with schools setting up camp, checking in and taking part in the display and presentation, scrabble, design and construction

components of the competition.

In its 27th year, the 2018 EB is expected to draw huge crowds to the region, with 365 teams from 155 schools taking part in the event.

The Triathlon category, which includes the time trial, Obstacle

Rally and eight-hour endurance trial, has recorded its biggest field ever with 71 entrants.

This year is the first time the EB will be running without a major sponsor after RACV, which has supported the EB since 1992,

dropped the event after altering its sponsorship agreements for 2018.

Despite lacking a major partner, the event is expected to draw more than 20,000 participants and spectators.
