
2017 PREP PARENT INFORMATION AFTERNOON





- Create an Acceptable Use Agreement for your families, ensure that your children are involved with this process.
- 2. Set up safe search and security controls
- Insist on all computers, laptops and mobile devices remaining outside of the bedroom
- 4. Lights out means then the Wi-Fi may be turned off.
- 5. Recharge mobile phones and devices outside bedrooms at night.
- 6. Get involved online and show an interest in what your child is doing
- Talk to your child's teacher/s and school to see what programs they recommend.
- Dont threaten to take away your child s devices as it may force them to become secretive.
- 9. Learn how various social network services work.
- 10.Tell children not to respond to any cyberbullying threats or comments online. However, do not delete any of the messages – keep records to verify and prove there is cyberbullying.


