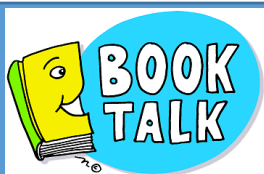
**This year grade 3/4B's mascot is Squiggles!**

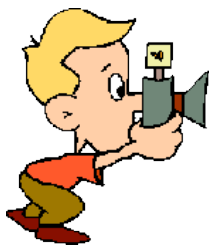
