Attendance

School absenteeism and truancy can impact significantly on students' learning and wellbeing.

Research shows that in Victoria, higher student attendance is associated, on average, with higher student achievement. Additionally, attending school every day helps children to build social and emotional skills such as communication, teamwork and resilience.

Under the law, you must make sure your child is enrolled and attends school on all school days unless there is a reasonable excuse. Schools monitor attendance of students and follow up with parents and caregivers any unexplained absences. If your child is absent without explanation you will receive an SMS from Compass at 10am, you are then able to go into Compass and enter the explanation or call the school to let us know.

If your child does not want to go to school, or is missing school without your knowing, contact your school immediately for assistance and support.

If you would like to enrol your children in the Holiday Program - please take note of the following:-

- 1. Cost is \$50.00 per child per day. With the introduction of the new Child Care Subsidy it is vital that all families have registered with Centrelink and have a copy of your new approved hours and percentage. If your approved hours are more than the number of hours you require you will be charged the full amount of \$50.00 for any additional hours. If you are unsure as to your eligibility or you have not vet registered your details please contact Centrelink direct on 136 150.
- 2. Eastbourne Primary School has an EFTPOS facility, phone payments or direct payment into the school's bank account for any parents who wish to use this method of payment.
- 3. Activities include Fishing excursion, Camping Day, Beach Excursion, Laser Tag and lots more.
