All year levels will perform a song each backed by the choir. All students are encouraged to wear accessories or clothes inspired by Christmas.


After carolling, there will be a sausage sizzle, Santa might join us, a disco and Dee and Kevin Vis from The Calmer Miles will be performing.


Students need to be supervised by an adult at all times. Please no pets, no smoking, no alcohol and




