

Next week, all Year 3 & 5 students will sit four tests as part of the National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN). Please note the following dates for this testing schedule.

Grade 5

Wednesday 15th May - Writing Friday 17th May - Reading Monday 20th May - Language Conventions Thursday 23rd May - Numeracy

We hope that all students will be able to sit this important testing, so that we can capture this point in time 'snapshot' of their capabilities and then use this data down the track to align with our school's own comprehensive data sets.

Where students are absent for one or more tests, arrangements will be made for those students to sit the tests on either the afternoon of the test days, or on Friday 24th May. Students who are absent for the three test days will not be expected to complete these tests on Friday 17th May.


The theme for Art this Term is Sustainability.
