UPCOMING SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Upcoming School Council Elections All government schools in Victoria have a School Council. They are legally constituted bodies that are given powers to set the key directions of a school within state-wide guidelines. In doing this, a School Council is able to directly influence the quality of education that the school provides for its students.

Parents on School Councils provide important viewpoints and have valuable skills that can help shape the direction of the school. Those parents who become active on a School Council find their involvement satisfying in itself and may also find that their children feel a greater sense of belonging/engagement. Each year, approximately half of the School council retires to allow new members to become involved. To this end, we are now formally calling for nominations for the 2018/2019 Tootgarook PS School Council. Membership on the council is for a period of two years and meetings are held on 3rd Monday of each Month. Councillors will also become members of one of the following subcommittees of council: Education, Facilities & Finance and Community Engagement.

If you would like to know more about being a councillor, don't hesitate to give me a call. In 2018, we have *three parent vacancies* and two teacher vacancies on School Council for a full period of two years.

Nominations for School Council will close at 4.00pm on Wednesday 21st February. Please contact the office for a nomination form if you are interested. If we receive more nominations that positions available, an election process will follow in the coming weeks.




GRADE 3 & 4 CATHOLIC FAMILIES
