ANZAC DAY REMINDER TUESDAY 25TH APRIL 2017


A reminder that the school will be closed on Tuesday 25th April for the annual ANZAC Day Public Holiday.

Application forms are available from the school office.


State Schools' Relief Prep CSEF uniform support is also available for Prep parents – an order form will be sent home to parents next week.
