

A MESSAGE TO PARENTS FROM SOUTHERN PENINSULA AQUATIC CENTRE ACTION GROUP



We are an action group recently formed at a meeting at Seawinds Community Hub, Capel Sound. Participants include residents from across the Southern Peninsula. Our common goal is to encourage our Shire Council to plan, construct and open an aquatic centre that can meet the diverse needs of the Southern Peninsula Community, by 2020. We are keen to encourage and work with Council in any way that we can to achieve this outcome.

It is vital that ratepayers, residents and organisations communicate their needs and a sense of urgency to our Council. In particular, we encourage parents to advocate for this development, on behalf of their Southern Peninsula children of all ages and abilities. This development is now even more important given the State Government announcement, that it wants all students to be able to swim 50metres, by the end of Grade 6. Without a Southern Peninsula Aquatic Centre, this goal will be hard to achieve. Can you assist us to raise a united voice for the long overdue development of this important community facility?
